Pre-K Program



Dear East Chicago Parent:

Plans have been made to provide a **Pre-K PROGRAM** for three to five year old children/preschoolers beginning Fall 2008.

In order to qualify, parents must present the following:

1. Your child's physical examination including: a) T.B. Skin Test, b) Lead Poisoning, c) and/or test report results for Sickle Cell (optional)
2. Your child's immunization records including: a) DTaP (4), b) Polio (3), c) Measles (1)/Rubella (1)/Mumps (1), d) Hepatitis B (3), e) Varicella (chickenpox) (1) or written parent or physician documentation stating the child has had the chickenpox disease and the date of the disease
3. Personal and Family Health History (will be completed at pre-enrollment)
4. Your child's original birth certificate
5. Your child's original social security card
6. Your child's Modified Clinical Technique (MCT) Vision Screening will be completed in school, with your signed consent, by an optometrist at no charge. You may also have the MCT completed by your personal optometrist.
7. Parent/Guardian's original photo ID
8. Proof of residency which is (2) originals of: utility bills with address (NIPSCO, Cable, and Water)

In addition to the above, if you rent, you must provide a notarized letter from your landlord and a copy of **ONE** of the following:

1. Your W-2 form (cross out your income) with your current home address
2. Your pay stub (cross out your income) with your current home address
3. TANF or Food Stamp Case number

Classes will be held Monday through Friday at Lincoln, Harrison and Washington Elementary Schools from 8:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and from 11:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at each elementary school listed. **Transportation must be provided by the parent.**

This is an excellent opportunity to help prepare your child for school. If you are interested, please enroll your student at any of the three schools designated below. Applications will be filled on a first come, first serve basis.

**** ALL students must be toilet trained in order to enroll.**
